Creating Gifts for the Holidays

The workshop introduces to artists and digital photographer two basic digital image transfer techniques for art papers and aluminum sheet using your digital computer and inkjet printer. Digital Art Studios Seminars has made available a new transfer film for creating “Polaroid like” transfers using a simple gel. Also, printing of aluminum using an inkAID precoat will be demonstrated in the workshop. Learn new art making techniques and avoid Christmas shopping. Participants need to bring their ready to print Photoshop files on a flash drive or CD.

Alcohol gel transfer technique

- Printing out on DASS transfer film
- Transfer technique demonstration using alcohol gel
- Image printed on DASS transfer film on Epson 2200 printer
- Transfer image onto Arches 88 waterleaf paper, 100% cotton and acid-free

InkAID precoat demonstration

- Printing on aluminum sheet 1 mil thickness
- Preparing aluminum for printing: cutting, remove oil film, clean with soap, water and alcohol
- Precoat with inkAID, 2 coats
- Place on carrier sheet with double stick tape
- Print with inkjet printer
- Spray with Crystal Clear to protect image

Roger Lee, is a new resident artist at the CorkStop Studios, and will lead the workshop. He is a faculty member in the Digital Art Program at Cuesta College.
